

The photographs strike at the viewer's heart with their glimpses of Salinas; they're images that could grace the cover of National Geographic.

The 16 pictures result from the efforts of a small group of teenagers who traipsed across the city for a week in August 2010 as part of a photo documentary project.

For the past year, these images have been making their way

around Salinas as a traveling exhibit sponsored by The California Endowment's Building Healthy Communities initiative. The initiative is a 10-year, \$1 billion project aimed at creating a healthier environment for children and youth in impoverished areas around the state. East Salinas is one of 14 communities chosen to focus on improving issues such as employment, education, housing and neighborhood safety.
