

# **Program Intern**

Venice Arts is pleased to announce an internship opportunity, the Program Intern position. Venice Arts is a non-profit organization whose mission is to ignite, expand, and transform the lives of Los Angeles' low-income youth through photography and film education, and uses our participatory storytelling practice to amplify the voices of underrepresented communities around the world.

Please note this internship is part of the Arts Internship Program with LA County.

# Description

The Program Intern will work in the classroom and administrative office July to November 2024, providing support to the Venice Arts' Media Arts Education & Mentoring Program.

The ideal candidate has an interest in media arts (e.g., photography, filmmaking, animation and comic arts) and/or arts education. They should be familiar with basic computer skills such as typing, creating documents and file management. Having some experience with using Adobe software and digital cameras is a plus. Candidates should be organized and motivated, and be comfortable with working with youth in a community-based setting. Customer service experience or previous experience working in a public facing role is a plus.

### Tasks will include:

- Running our student check in/out during Media Arts Summer Camp and on Saturdays during the Academic Year.
- Photographing program activities and culling and editing pictures for outreach collateral
- Serving as general classroom support, specifically:
  - Assisting with classroom setup/breakdown
  - Assisting with material distribution during class
  - Providing technical support to students
  - Providing mentoring support and assisting students with projects
  - Maintaining class files including following file naming conventions
- Supporting with general gallery and public programming including:
  - Patching nail holes and painting walls
  - Assisting with hanging of artwork
  - Helping to design and print collateral and gallery labels
  - Set up and take down of programming space including moving furniture up to 25lbs
  - Assisting with the run of the show including (re)stocking refreshments, staffing an information or sales table.
- Supporting with general administrative and media needs, including:
  - Assisting with file management of current students' work

- Assisting with the cataloging and labeling of past student work and photographic documentation of past workshops
- Assisting with software updates and file management such as backing up student work to Google drive
- Answering phone calls, filing, printing, and copying

#### Qualifications

The Program Intern candidate must have the following qualifications:

- Is currently enrolled as an undergraduate college student. This can include students enrolled in associate degree (community college) programs.
- Is a resident of Los Angeles County attending college outside of the region or currently attending college in Los Angeles County.
- Is able to legally work within the United States.

Students who are on track to complete their undergraduate degree, or transfer from a community college to a four-year institution between May 1 - December 1, 2024, are eligible.

You would **not** be eligible to participate if:

- You have already earned a Bachelor of the Arts, Bachelor of Science, or a higher degree. (Prospective graduates who will complete their undergraduate degree between May 1, 2024, and December 1, 2024, need not be currently enrolled at the time of the internship.)
- You have previously participated in the Arts Internship Program.
- You are a current or former staff member, of Venice Arts
- You are a relative of a current employee, board member, trustee, officer, and/or director of Venice Arts.

### Hours/Schedule

Ideal candidates will be on-boarded and begin training on July 1. The Program Intern must be available for 40 hours per week (Monday-Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm) during our Media Arts Summer Camp, July 8 - August 2. The Program Intern must be available for 15 hours a week for the remainder of their internship. Beginning September 7, the Program Intern must be available Saturdays 9am-4pm for our Fall Workshops.

## Compensation

This is a temporary, non exempt, hourly internship with a rate of \$17.28/hour.
